Welcome to your Copperplate Guidelines

It is recommended that you print these on 120gsm or #32lb laser copy paper.

Doing so will minimize any ink bleed if you will be practising on them.

If you own a light box or a LED copy board, they can be used under your project as a lettering guide.

Hint: Laminate the guide before placing on your light box so you can wipe any ink bleed off easily.

One way to practice is to use the large guidelines first and progressively use the smaller guides until you achieve the fine control needed for the smaller writing.

The exemplar is useful as a starter point for letter forming. Your personal style will develop and over time you will combine some strokes for small lettering.

The Guide assistant is designed to help you draw guidelines on many projects and adhere to proper ratios.
